

# LEAD COMPANY COSTUMES

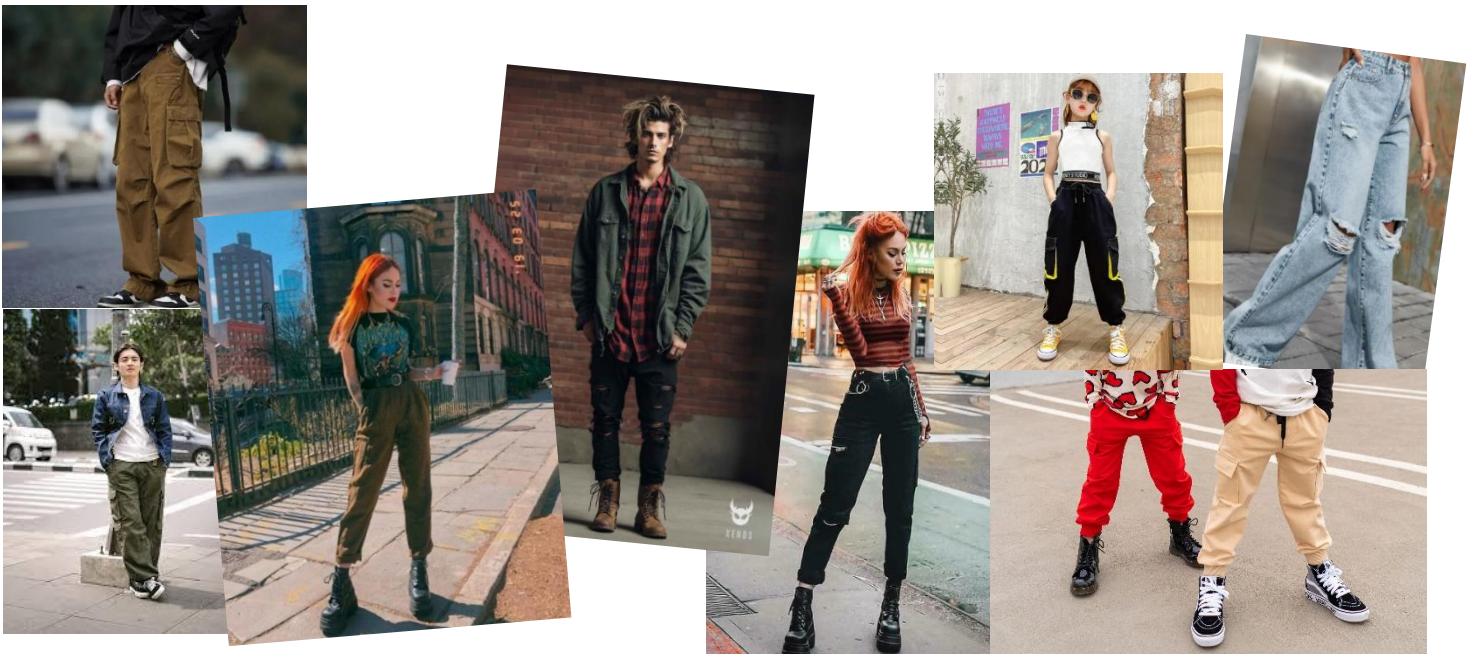
## OUTFIT #1 – STREET WEAR

When the show starts, you will be an average person in New York City. Therefore, your outfit needs to be something we could reasonably see as “street wear.”

Remember: this is not “middle schooler in Bucks County” streetwear. Please follow the guidelines below to ensure you have the right look.

Bottoms	Tops
<p>Jeans and cargo style pants are both acceptable (NO LEGGINGS OR SWEATPANTS)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bottoms can be black, denim, khaki, or army green (think traditional cargo pants)</li> <li>• Jeans can have rips and distressed elements!</li> <li>• If you choose to wear jeans, please make sure they are a looser style. This will help you move more easily on stage, and also contribute to the New York street style. <i>(No skinny jeans!)</i></li> </ul>	<p>A t-shirt or long-sleeved shirt.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>MUST BE BLUE!</b> Any shade, any pattern (stripes, etc.)...but the base color must be blue.</li> <li>• No large logos or numbers</li> <li>• No crop tops</li> </ul> <p>Feel free to add layers! A plaid shirt, leather jacket, denim jacket, or vest can elevate your look. Again, stick in shades of blue, black or white.</p>
Shoes	
<p>Sneakers or boots. These should be stylish, match your outfit, and easy to dance in. Suggested styles (not necessarily brands) include: Converse, Vans, Nike Court/Dunk/Blazer, New Balance, combat boots, etc.</p>	
Accessories	
<p>Add in an individual flare with your accessories!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Acceptable accessories: gloves (including fingerless gloves), hats/beanies, belts, bandanas/headbands/hair bows, jewelry, etc.</li> </ul>

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## OUTFIT #2 – CAMP HALF-BLOOD

Later in the show, you will be a camper at Camp Half-Blood. You will wear the same pants and shoes from your first outfit, but change your shirt into your provided “Camp Half-Blood” shirt and camp necklace!

**We are asking that each actor submit \$5 to go toward the cost of their Camp Half-Blood shirt.**

This will be professionally printed, and they get to keep it at the end of the show!  
*(We are selling them in the gear store for more, so it's a steal!)*



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## UNDERGARMENTS

Everyone should also have the following undergarments:

- Girls: A nude tank top/camisole OR nude leotard
- Boys: A plain white tank top
- Both: Plain socks that match your shoes. Meaning: If you Have white shoes, make sure your socks are plain white. If you have black shoes, make sure your socks are plain black. No patterns or visible logos (like the Nike swoosh).
